Name one significant difficulty in your life that challenged your view or expectations of God.


## **Discussion:**

- 2. What aspects of "the dark night" might have been tormenting Abraham's soul as he bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar?



- 3. In light of this story, how is your image or idea of God challenged?
- 4. What are some possible reasons you have a hard time accepting and moving through walls?
- 5. [Group leader reads first part of question] How might this larger perspective serve as an encouragement to you today?
- 6. [Group leader reads first part of question] How might this encourage you in any current walls you are facing?

## **Application:**

- A deeper ability to wait on God
- A greater detachment from the world
