- When we are devoted to seeking the Lord, what does that lead to?

Psalm 35:9 – My soul will rejoice in the Lord and delight in his salvation.

- Why can it be such a struggle for our soul to do this?
- What have you found to be a key in seeing your soul do this?

Psalm 42:2 – My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.

- What does it mean and look like for our soul to thirst for God?
- What do you think thirsting for God will lead to and produce?

Psalm 62:1 – Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him.

- What does it mean and look like for our soul to find rest in God?
- What relationship does our salvation have with finding rest in Him?

Hebrews 6:19 – We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.

- Describe the ways that the hope you have in Jesus is an anchor for your soul.
- How have you found that anchor to be firm and secure specifically for your soul?

1 Peter 1:9 – You are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your soul.

- Why is salvation specifically for our soul?
- Describe how the salvation of our soul is the end result of our faith.
